Overview

The Global Script Manager plugin is a simple yet powerful tool that allows users to effortlessly add custom scripts and code snippets to the <head> and <body> sections of a WordPress site. You can manage these scripts globally for the entire site or apply them to individual pages, offering unparalleled flexibility and control.

Features

- ✤ Add custom scripts to the <head> or <body> tags site-wide.
- ✤ Page-specific script insertion for granular control.
- ✤ User-friendly interface for easy management.
- Compatible with all WordPress themes and plugins.
- ✤ No coding knowledge is required.

Installation

Follow these simple steps to download, install, and activate the Global Script Manager or any other WordPress plugin provided by Zinavo:

Step 1: Download the Plugin from the Zinavo website

Save the plugin file (a .zip file) to your computer.

Step 2: Upload the Plugin to WordPress

Log in to your WordPress admin dashboard.

Navigate to Plugins > Add New.

Click the Upload Plugin button at the top of the page.

Select Choose File, then browse your computer to find the downloaded .zip file from Zinavo.

Click Install Now to begin the upload and installation process.

Step 3: Install the Plugin

Once the upload is complete, WordPress will display a success message.

Click the Activate Plugin button to enable the plugin on your site.

Step 4: Verify Plugin Activation

After activation, the plugin will appear in the Installed Plugins list.

Depending on the plugin, a new menu item (e.g., Global Script Manager) may appear in the WordPress admin dashboard for configuration and management.

How to Use

- Global Script Management
- Go to Settings > Global Script Manager.
- Add your code snippets in the respective fields:
- Head Scripts: For scripts that should appear in the <head> section (e.g., Google Analytics, Meta tags, Conversation code).
- Body Scripts: For scripts that should appear in the <body> section (e.g., custom JavaScript, tracking codes).
- Click Save Changes to apply the scripts site-wide.

Page-Specific Scripts

- Edit the desired page or post in WordPress.
- Scroll to the Global Script Manager meta box in the editor.
- Add your scripts to the Head or Body fields.
- Update or publish the page to save changes.

Use Cases

- SEO Optimization: Add custom meta tags or schema markup to the head section.
- Tracking & Analytics: Insert tracking codes (e.g., Google Analytics, Meta Pixel).
- Custom Styles or Scripts: Add custom CSS or JavaScript to enhance your site's functionality.

Best Practices

- Always test your scripts in a staging environment before applying them to a live site.
- Avoid duplicating scripts in global and page-specific sections to prevent conflicts.
- Keep your code lightweight to ensure fast loading times.
